Welcome to the Cloud County Ground, Chelmsford!

Whilst you watch today's match, keep an eye out for some things that are going on around the ground. Let's get to know some things first...



Hi! I'm Mia and I play for Sunrisers. Join me as we meet the team, get to know a bit more about cricket, and explore the ground!

What is cricket?

Cricket is a sport played by two teams. Each team has 11 players in the game.

One team bats whilst the other fields. The fielding team has a wicket-keeper, a bowler, and nine fielders. There are two batters at a time.

The bowler bowls the ball with a straight arm, aiming to hit the stumps behind the batter. If the ball hits the stumps, or a fielder catches the ball the batter hits, this is called a wicket! The fielding team need to get 10 wickets to get a go at batting.

The batting team will try score as many runs as possible, whilst trying to not get out. Then they swap over, and the team that scores the most runs wins!

Who are Sunrisers?

Sunrisers are one of eight teams in the English domestic women's cricket system. Our first season was in 2020, where we played matches after the first COVID summer lockdown ended. We play our home games mainly at Chelmsford, but have also played at Northampton and Radlett this season.

What shirt number is the wicket-keeper wearing?






Who bowled the tenth over?
